### **Moore Class Trip to: The Science Museum – Wonderlab and 3D Antarctica – Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> June.**

We have booked a Moore class trip to on **The Science Museum, London on Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> June**, to support our learning from this term and next term about Animals and Nutrition, Living things and their habitats and Changing State.

We will be catching the 9:25am train from Otford train station to London Victoria and then catching the Underground for 2 stops to South Kensington Station, where it is a short walk to the museum. We therefore would be grateful if parents could make arrangements to drop children off at Otford train station **by 9:10am**. If you are unable to drop your child for this trip you will need to make your own arrangements with another family. Please let the school know if your child will be travelling with someone else.

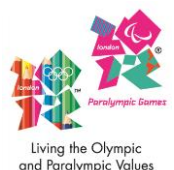
In the Wonder Show, they will experience the wonder of science through exciting experiments and demos through a medley of experiments and demonstrations that are jam-packed with WOW moments and opportunities to volunteer, the Wonder Show is designed to inspire children about science. They will observe chemical reactions and use these to support children's understanding of matter. Explore different sources of light, from bioluminescence in the natural world to luminol used in forensic investigations. See how sound travels and understand how it can be used in real life from ultrasound to echolocation.

The performance starts at 11:00am and lasts approximately 20 minutes. We will then have lunch before watching the fully immersive, 3D Antarctica film in the IMAX cinema at the Science Museum, which lasts 1 hour. We will then return to London Victoria train station to catch the 14:55 train back to Otford. This is due to arrive at Otford station at 15:31. Please could you make arrangements to collect your child from Otford Station or if you are unable to do this yourself make arrangements with another family.

On the day, children will need to bring a small snack and a packed lunch plus their water bottle in a named small back pack to make it easier to carry, but please leave book bags at home. We are a nut free school so please ensure that you do not include any nuts. School uniform and **school caps** must be worn please.

You are required to complete a consent form for this event; this will give permission for your child to attend and for the teacher in charge of the party to give consent on your behalf for any urgent medical treatment, including anaesthetic to be given. Once these steps have been completed, you will be able to proceed with a payment.



You will also need to indicate who will be transporting your child to the station. We request that if you are unable to drop or collect your child at the venue that you make your own arrangements with another family to transport your child.

Please register by Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May. If we do not hear from you by this date then we will assume that your child is not able to participate.

We will be looking for a few volunteers to help with this trip so please indicate on the form if you would be able to.

We would like to take this opportunity to remind parents that if you need help with payment for this event, please write to Mrs Lovatt-Young who will consider the application for support on a confidential basis.
